

Biosecurity

For Raptor Keepers



All falconers have a duty to maintain good biosecurity and watch for signs & symptoms of bird flu.

Solid Roofs

Cover housing with solid roofs where possible or at least ensure eating areas and baths are undercover

Call Your Vet

If you have any concerns about the health of your birds

Footwear Change

Use different footwear at home to what you use while in the field

Avoid Wild Birds

Contact should be avoided with wild birds

Use Foot Dips

With DEFRA approved disinfectants
20cm Deep

Pest Control

Rodents spread the virus on their bodies

Some bird species can carry bird flu without seeming unwell.

It is important not to feed your raptors any wild birds. Freezing does NOT kill bird flu.
